Mor. 1:6	-	311 AD	Mormon is born to his father Mormon and mother.
Mor. 1:2	10	321	Ammaron tells the young boy about the plates deposited, seek to obtain when 24 years old.
Mor. 1:6	11	322	Moves to Zarahemla. This same year war begins.
Mor. 1:12	11-15	322-326	The war ends and peace for four years.
Mor. 1:15	15	326	Mormon is visited by the Lord, forbidden to preach.
Mor. 2:2	16	327	Mormon is appointed leader of Nephite army.
Mor. 2:3-8	17	328	Frightened Nephites retreat to north countries. Fighting ensues, blood and carnage spread throughout all the land.
Mor. 2:9	19	330	Mormon beats Aaron with 42k men against 44k.
Mor. 2:10-15	20-33	331-344	Nephites begin to repent for wicked reasons. They are in open rebellion against God.
Mor. 2:16	34	345	War continues. Mormon obtains the deposited plates. He writes on them of the wickedness and abominations he has seen. City Shem is fortified.
Mor. 2:22-27	35-38	346-349	Mormon's words arouse Nephites to fight, they beat an army of 50k with their 30k. The Lord's strength is not with them. Mormon's heart sorrows. They retake their own lands.
Mor. 2:28	39	350	A treaty is signed. Nephites inherit the north and the Lamanites the south.
Mor. 3:1-3	39-49	350-360	Peace in the land. Mormon preaches in vain.
Mor. 3:4	49	360	Epistle from Lamanites, they are coming to battle. Nephites fortify Desolation.
Mor. 3:7	50	361	Lamanites come and Nephites win.
Mor. 3:8	51	362	Lamanites come again, Nephites win again. The Nephites swear and boast in own strength. Mormon refuses to lead them. Lord says vengeance is His and He will repay the Nephites for avenging blood. Mormon is an idle witness.
Mor. 4:1	52	363	Nephites go to battle Lamanites. Nephites lose.
Mor. 4:7	53	364	Lamanites come to battle Nephites. Lamanites lose.
Mor. 4:15	56	367	Nephites go to battle Lamanites. Nephites lose.
Mor. 4:16	56-64	367-375	Relative peace for eight years.
Mor. 4:16-23	64	375	Lamanites begin to sweep the Nephites to extinction. Nephites lose the land Desolation. Nephites driven and slaughtered. Mormon retrieves all of the records from the hill Shim.
Mor. 5:1-5	68	379	Mormon becomes their leader again. Nephites maintain some cities. Lamanites destroying and burning towns, villages, and cities.
Mor. 5:6-6:4	69-73	380-384	Lamanites pursue fleeing Nephites. Those who were swifter in flight escaped. The light of Christ ceases to strive with them. Mormon laments.
Mor. 6:5-8:3	74	385	Mormon finishes the Book of Mormon including his commentary in The Words of Mormon. He hides all plates except the ones he gave Moroni. Hundreds of thousands of Nephites are hewn down. Mormon and all the Nephite nation killed save Moroni only.

## MORONI

Mor. 8:1-10:34

385-421

Moroni continues record. He is alone. Writes in the record. Does not mention time except mentions briefly in Moroni 10:1 that it is 421AD. Buries plates. He spends at least 36 years in isolation
